
### Step 1

To start, pour a third of the bag of Red Swiss Chard seeds into cold water to let them soak for 24 hours before planting, this will help them to grow better. Seal the seed packet back up and store them in a dry and cool place for another crop.



### Step 2

Next, add soil to the pot. Fill about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the pot with some sieved soil or multi-purpose compost available from garden centres. The soil or compost needs to be damp. Press the soil down to make a flat surface.



### Step 3

Evenly scatter the seeds in the pot and cover with a layer (about the thickness of a pea) of more soil.



### Step 4

Place the pot on a warm windowsill or similarly in a well-lit position and water regularly with Peppa's Garden Playhouse!




### Step 5

Your Red Swiss Chard should be ready to eat after 8 - 12 days. Cut them with scissors (an adult should help you with this),




Give these both a wash and they're ready to add to your food - like salads or pizza!



## Top Tips!


Red Swiss Chard is incredibly rich in vitamin A (which helps you see in the dark!)

Red Swiss Chard can be grown at any time of the year as long as you can supply enough light.




### Step 1

Attach the tyre swing to the spout with the locator points.




### Step 2

Fix the ladder and both fences onto the top of the watering can.




### Step 3

Slot the doorstep underneath the door frame and pop the pot in the watering can.



### Step 4

Slot the fence from underneath, this can be used across our other Peppa lines!



### Parsnips

Keeping the tops from parsnips or any other root crops (such as carrot, beetroots, turnips etc.) will allow you to regrow them!

Place the tops in a container of water and new, green tops should begin to grow in a few days.

You can simply harvest and use these greens as they grow, or you can allow the roots to continue growing until the plants are ready to be transplanted into the ground.
