Trouble	Solution
No reaction after power on	Please plug the USB port into your PC/ Laptop/ Wall charge / Power bank.
Inadequate or low luminance at the greatest luminous	Charge an USB bank with enough power.
The light is loose	Please ensure the angle adjustable knob on the 1/4" ball head adapter is tightened.
Phone holder doesn't stay on the mount	Please make sure the cap on the goose is tightened.

1. Can I use it without a mobile phone?

2. Can the phone be rotated between landscape and portrait orientation?
