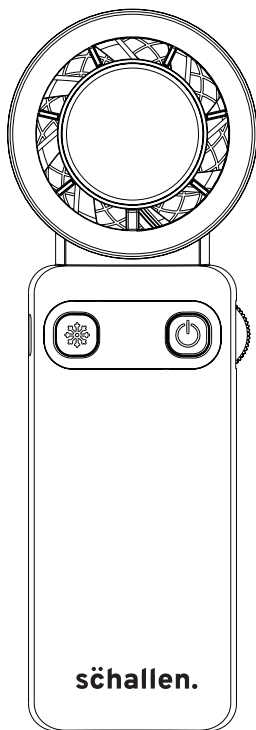

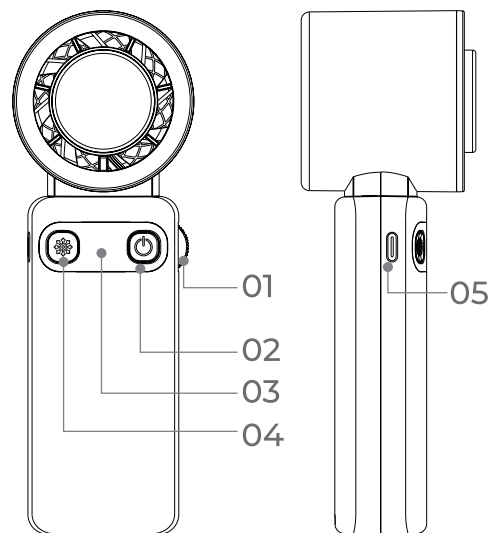

01- Gear Control Button

02 - Power / Fan Button

03 - LED Display

04 - Cooling Button

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power & Fan Control

- Press  once to switch the device on. The LED display will show the current fan speed.
- Adjust fan speed using the control :
 - Scroll up to increase airflow
 - Scroll down to decrease airflow
- Press  again to switch the device off.

Cooling Function

- While the device is switched on, press the Cooling Button  to activate cooling mode. A snowflake icon will appear on the display.
- Press  again to turn the cooling function off.

ADDITIONAL FEATURES

Memory Function

- The device remembers the last fan speed used before switching off and will return to this setting when powered back on.

Auto Display Reset

- If no buttons are pressed for approximately 5 seconds, the display will automatically return to showing the battery level.

Battery Status

- When the battery level falls below 9%, the percentage on the display will flash.
- The device will automatically switch off when the battery reaches 0%.

Use While Charging

- The device can be used whilst charging; however, only the fan function is available. The cooling function cannot be used while charging.

Charging Display

- During charging, the display shows the battery level (1-100%).
- The percentage symbol (%) will flash while charging.
- When fully charged, the display will show 100% continuously.



SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- This product should not be used by children or individuals who are unfamiliar with these instructions without appropriate supervision.
- **Do not** insert fingers or any objects into the fan grille, rear cover, or moving blades.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, and fabrics away from the fan at all times to prevent entanglement or injury.
- This product contains a rechargeable battery.
- When disposing of the product, follow local regulations for electronic waste and battery recycling.

WARNING:

Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury, damage to the product, or reduced performance:

- **Do not** use this product in humid environments such as bathrooms, or expose it to water or other liquids. Doing so may cause malfunction or damage.
- **Do not** drop, knock, or repeatedly tap the product, as this may cause internal damage.
- **Do not** attempt to disassemble, modify, or repair the product yourself.
- **Do not** dispose of the product in fire, as this may result in explosion or injury.

MAINTENANCE & CARE

- Clean the fan using a dry, soft cloth.

Please dispose of all packaging materials responsibly and in accordance with local recycling guidelines.

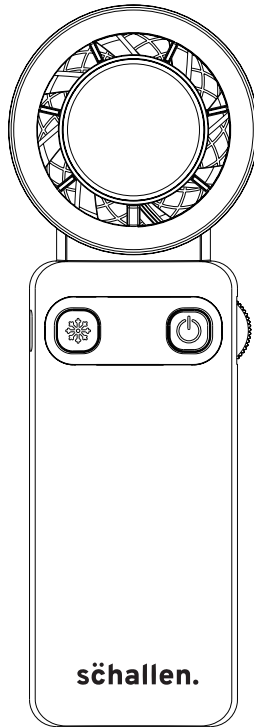
- Separate the materials by type.
