

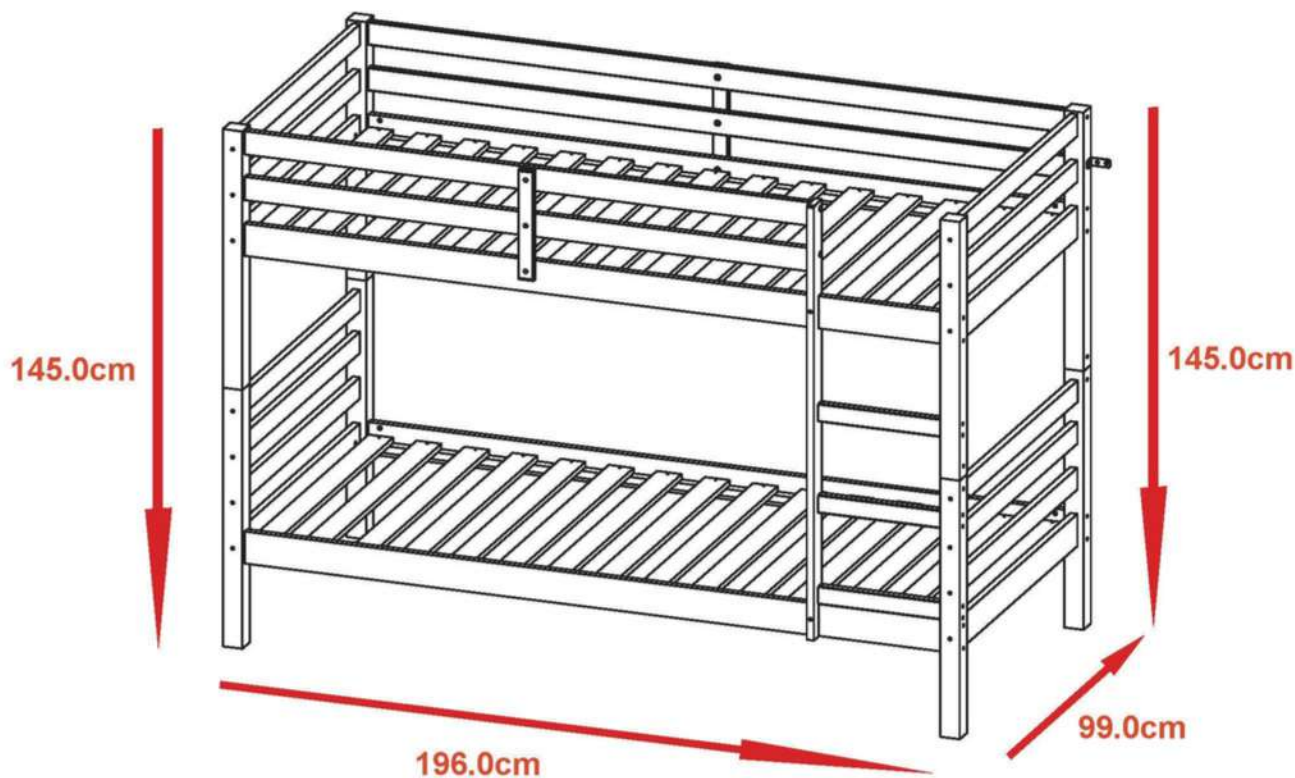

- Check you have all the components, parts, hardware and tools listed on pages 3, 4.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to lay out the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft, level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws, as this could damage the unit.

Only use hand screwdrivers.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

HELPFUL HINTS

- Please read through the assembly instructions thoroughly before you begin.
- Check all fittings and panels against the parts list to ensure that you have everything before you start. In the unlikely event that any parts are missing, please contact your retailer immediately.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups in a bowl or other container to stop any small parts being lost.
- Do not use any tool that's not listed in these assembly instructions. The use of power tools is NOT advised, this could damage your product and cause over tightening to occur.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people. Look for this logo 
- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the next page.

- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

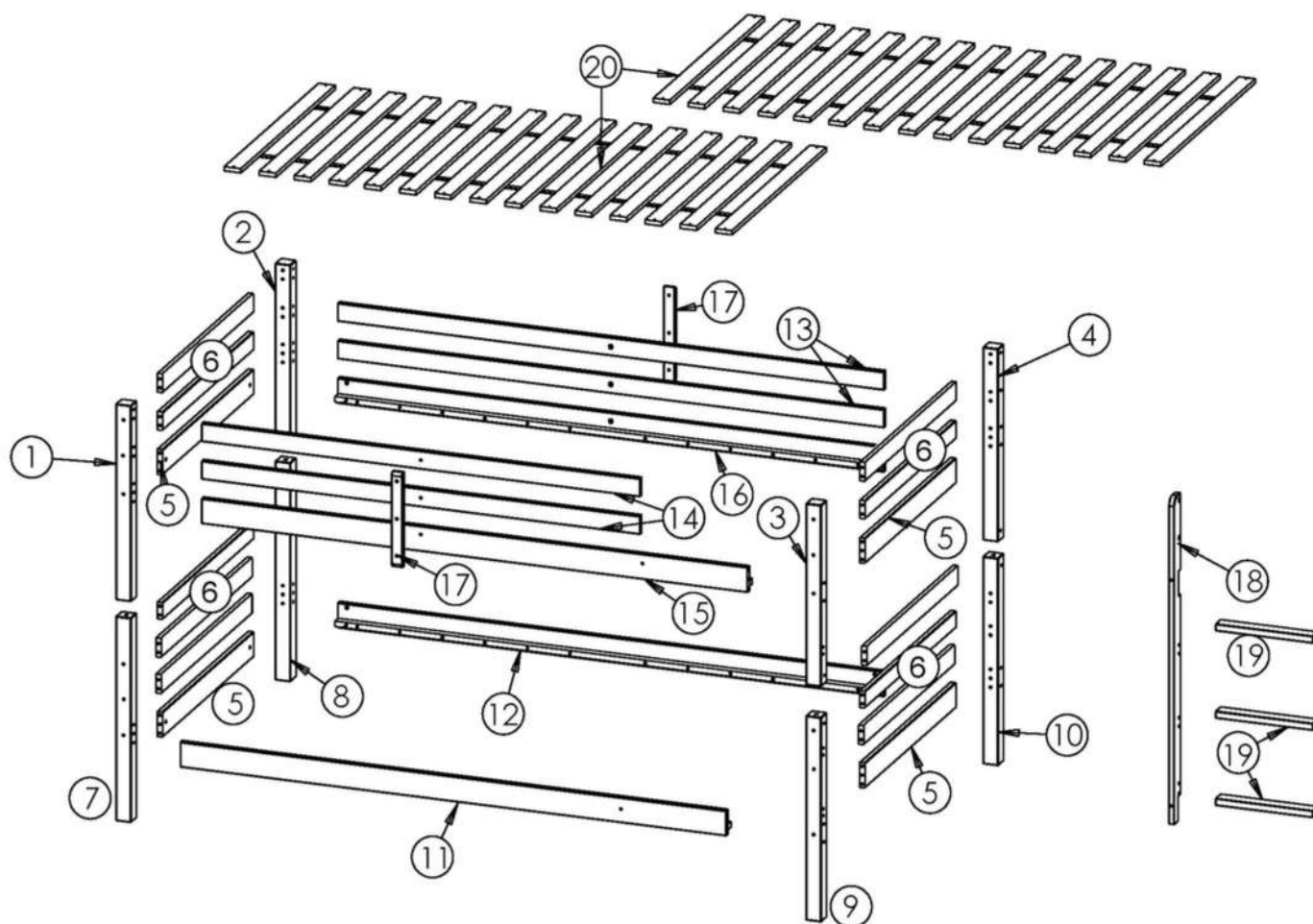
Care and Maintenance

Philip Screwdriver & Drill (Not Provided) are required to attached the bed with L-bracket (M) to the wall.

SAFETY WARNING

- All bunk beds and high beds intended to be assembled by someone other than the manufacturer or their representative shall contain assembly instructions, a list of parts supplied and details of any tools required to assemble the bed.
 - We recommend that you use the mattress at size: 1900 x 900 x 160mm
 - All assembly fastenings should always be tightened properly and that care should be taken that no fittings are loose.
 - Instructions regarding positioning and connection of the means of access.
 - The ladder is not for playing on, only use to climb onto top bunk.
 - We recommend only one person on the upper bunk at one time.
 - **Warning:** - The bunk bed or high bed should not be used if any structural part is broken or missing.
 - The top of the mattress shall be at least 160mm below the upper edge of the safety barriers.
 - **Warning:** - Children can become trapped between the bed and the wall.
To avoid risks of serious injury, the distance between the top barrier and the wall shall not exceed 75mm or shall be more than 230mm
 - **Warning:** - "High beds and upper level of the bunk beds are not suitable for children under six years due to the risk of injury from falls."
 - **Warning:** - "Bunkbeds and high beds can present a serious risk of injury from strangulation if not used correctly . Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed to be used with the bed, for example, but not limited to ropes, strings, cords, hooks, belts and bags.
 - The ventilation of the room is necessary in order to keep the humidity low and to prevent mold in and around the bed.
 - The manufacturer's instructions must be always followed.
